La sombra del impostor

BIENVENIDOS AL RENACIMIENTO. BIENVENIDOS AL CAOS. Alberto Caliani, el autor revelación de la novela histórica y galardonado con dos Premios Hsilibris 2021, vuelve con una novela que hará temblar los cimientos del género. Turín, siglo XVI. Esta es una historia sobre hombres corruptos que persiguen un fin noble, y hombres nobles que cometen atrocidades. También es un relato de locura y superstición; de un inquisidor implacable y de una joven ingeniera adelantada a su tiempo; de un padre y un hijo que se odian y se necesitan; de un buscavidas sin escrúpulos que descubrirá que vale más de lo que él mismo cree; de una adolescente que huye de sí misma hasta encontrarse al borde de la muerte, y de un misterioso asesino invisible que acecha entre las sombras. Pero, sobre todo, es una epopeya de violencia e intrigas para acabar con el papa de Roma y con las poderosas familias que mantienen dividida a una Italia debilitada por la guerra. Y todo ello, respaldado por una gran mentira que perdurará a través de los siglos.

Quisiera ser lluvia y noche - Mujer sombra

Por la noche, perderse en el bosque puede ser una pesadilla. Una novela que te dejará sin aliento hasta la última página. El miedo no es broma. El plan era simple: pasar una noche de campamento, y al otro día volver a casa. Nada más que eso. Seis amigos. Veinticuatro horas. Y un bosque. El plan era simple, sí. Pero a veces las cosas no son lo que parecen. Y los planes no salen como esperás.

El muro de los gentiles

La vida y la obra de Ezequiel Martínez Estrada, uno de los intelectuales más brillantes y menos reconocidos de la historia argentina. Ajedrecista, violinista aficionado, empleado de correos, profesor sin título habilitante, intelectual que seguía su propia senda, poeta laureado. Ezequiel Martínez Estrada escribió teatro, cuentos, una novela y cientos de ensayos y artículos de opinión que cimentaron su fama de polemista: "Me manejo como los cortaplumas que tienen tirabuzón, diamante de cortar vidrios, punzón, brújula y lima de uñas". Sin embargo, fueron los análisis sociológicos y políticos sobre el país #los principales: Radiografía de la pampa, La cabeza de Goliat y Muerte y transfiguración de Martín Fierro# los que le dieron renombre continental y lo convirtieron en el ensayista argentino más importante del siglo XX. Receloso, desmesurado e intransigente, vivió atormentado por la suerte de una nación que amaba y el descrédito de sus profecías. Tuvo amigos también, entre los desesperados: Leopoldo Lugones y Horacio Quiroga, quien desmontó un terreno al lado de su cabaña para llevarlo a vivir con él en la selva misionera. De procedencia plebeya y raigambre libertaria, fue figura destacada del aristocrático grupo Sur, donde cruzó antipatías con Jorge Luis Borges y Adolfo Bioy Casares, aunque tejió una amistad profunda con Victoria Ocampo. No fue adepto a Perón, pero también fue crítico de todos los gobiernos que siguieron. Ya de grande dio apoyo a la Revolución Cubana y terminó viviendo en La Habana, casi feliz. Murió inconsolable en 1964, dos años después de volver de la isla. Con esta biografía monumental, Christian Ferrer revela la complejidad de un pensador controvertido e imprescindible para comprender la Argentina. Severo y paradójico, este Martínez Estrada que enseñaba a cantar a los pájaros es también luminoso.

Lluvia vive por y para su hija Iris. Por ella sería capaz de todo, hasta de dibujar en su cara una sonrisa que maquille el cansancio y los problemas con los que tropieza cada día. Su vida se pintaba con otros colores diferentes al blanco y negro... Era joven... debajo de las piedras para pagar las facturas a primeros de mes, por no olvidar que debe robar horas al sueño para aprobar sus estudios. Ya se había adaptado a sus problemas... No necesitaba más... pero llegó Logan, el nuevo dueño del restaurante en el que trabaja. Es joven, eficiente, ordenado y... muy guapo... demasiado guapo para su propia salud... aunque hay una pega: tiene mal carácter. Todo lo que Logan tiene de sexi lo tiene de borde y parece que no le cae demasiado bien Lluvia. Si no fuera por Iris, quien logra arrancar una carcajada hasta al mismísimo demonio, de seguro que ya la habría despedido... o quizás no...

Historia de un bribón dichoso

Ramiro Sanchiz, una de las voces más particulares de la narrativa uruguaya contemporánea, compone una novela sugerente y seductora, impregnada de melancolía futurista. Todo pasó en los noventa: no solo se acabó el petróleo, sino que de los pozos agotados —y al mismo tiempo de las grandes concentraciones de basura en los océanos— creció la maraña, una forma de vida nueva, capaz de digerir el plástico y tóxica para los seres humanos. Esta gran pandemia casi destruyó la civilización, pero, a medida que avanzó el siglo xxi, la humanidad aprendió a sobrevivir en un mundo ya no globalizado. Un mundo de provincias por el ya Federico Stahl, antiguo virtuoso adolescente del piano, se pasea en una gira musical que lo llevará por pueblos oníricos e inquietantes, personajes singulares (como un anciano imitador de Michael Jackson y una estrella enana del porno argentino), carreteras en ruinas dentro de la jungla de maraña y secretos de futuros más extraños aun, que acechan en la espesura, entre piratas postapocalípticos, juguetes perdidos y viejas variaciones para piano. «Federico Stahl es uno de los grandes personajes de la literatura latinoamericana de este principio de siglo». El bosque

La novela histórica «Firma con mi nombre» nos presenta el latifundio chileno en la historia de la familia Pérez-Azaña: la vida privada de los dueños del fundo, los antepasados que forjaron el dominio de las tierras y con la vida, siempre interesante de sus descendientes mujeres que, en el claustro de una vida infectada por la atmósfera religiosa y pía, van encontrando los resquicios para el amor prohibido, para los secretos de alcoba, para sus pasiones sofocadas por el machismo y el dominio patriarcal. Los campesinos del pueblo de Cantarrana despiertan durante la década del '60 bajo la consigna de "La tierra para el que la trabaja". Pero, en 1973, comienza la revancha de los latifundistas.

El Señor de las lluvias y el viento

Considerada la primera novela conocida en la Argentina, su primera parte fue publicada en 1851, en forma de folletín, en el diario 'La Semana' de Montevideo. Interrumpida la publicación por el pronunciamiento del general Justo José de Urquiza contra Juan Manuel de Rosas, gobernador de la Provincia de Buenos Aires, apareció en forma de libro en Buenos Aires, en 1855, con el añadido de los ocho últimos capítulos. El hilo conductor del relato es el romance entre Amalia, una viuda bonaerense, y Eduardo Belgrano, un joven unitario herido al tratar de salir de Buenos Aires para incorporarse a las tropas que luchan contra Rosas.

Periódico oficial del gobierno

Esta obra analiza la relación entre el movimiento socio-político conocido con el nombre de fascismo y las películas de ambientación histórica producidas durante la primera etapa (1939-1953) de la dictadura del general Franco. Explora los usos ideológicos de este cine como una importante herramienta en la diseminación de la agenda política del fascismo español, así como la reappropriación de la historia nacional llevada a cabo por el franquismo como modo de obtener la hegemonía cultural en España tras la guerra civil. En cualquier caso, este libro muestra cómo este intento de rescribir la historia de España en una narrativa homogénea y coherente, en última instancia fallará debido a las contradicciones internas del proyecto franquista y de las propias películas que terminarán convirtiéndose en ejemplo de lo que he denominado kitsch fascista español.

La amargura metódica

¡Son tres! es la historia de cómo llegaron a la vida de la autora sus tres hijos. Desde la decisión de adoptar, pasando por aquellos primeros días juntos, de puro vértigo, hasta cómo fueron acomodándose a su nueva vida. El libro está dedicado a todos los niños que esperan con el corazón apretado encontrar

una familia que los adopte y a todas las personas que sienten el profundo deseo de ahijar. Reafirma el derecho que todos tenemos a ser hijos deseados y cuenta una historia de amor, demasiado intensa como para no compartirla. Esta es una historia sobre deseo, perseverancia y sobre cumplir sueños, los que cada uno se proponga.

Sin ti

Realidad que vivió un profesor misionero y clérigo de determinada colectividad con presencia en todos los continentes. A su carisma personal solo le satisface estar entre los marginados y olvidados en lugares de difícil acceso por distancia y geografía. A su debido tiempo de servicio, solicita el indulto del colectivo para que se le exonere de los votos emitidos de pobreza, castidad y obediencia y así dar comienzo a una nueva vida bajo otro estado civil, libre de ataduras religiosas. Su aventura da comienzo calzando las sandalias del otro con los infortunios y satisfacciones que encuentra en su camino. Presencia escenas escalofriantes de abuso infantil mientras estaba en plena formación básica Secundaria, luego Superior filosófica y teológica, esencialmente exigidos en su preparación dentro de un semillero. En las visitas pastorales campesinas en Sudamérica, enfrentó a padres de familia practicantes de incesto, que dejaban embarazadas a sus propias hijas, denunciando los mencionados hechos. Nos narra, además, cómo rescató de la pobreza a una abuela inválida y a su bisnieta y cómo esta niña campesina, con ayuda de la caridad, escaló socialmente hasta encontrar un estatus entre las élites. Nuestro protagonista siguió trabajando y predicando para los más necesitados desde diferentes puestos, en medio de una injusticia visible y compleja.

Un pianista de provincias

A lo largo de una vida escribiendo uno acierta y se equivoca, hace fácil lo difícil y se complica en lo simple, se culpa -parafraseando a Ignacio Suárez- por cosas que no tienen nada que ver con uno, y se va encerrando..., en mi caso con una tendencia a ser un tanto ermitaño que crece. Los años me han enseñado que más importante que la sapiencia es la curiosidad. Esa curiosidad me llevó por los caminos que expresa este libro. "Tristezas de autoayuda" es un texto que no tiene ambiciones filosóficas: no pretende cuestionar la existencia del alma ni asuntos así; solamente es la forma en la que canalicé un desasosiego para seguir viviendo. Es hermoso ser poeta... Pero es más hermoso -al menos para mí- en los bares comunes que en las tertulias, en las lunas que en los aplausos.

La inquilina del vestido azul

El manejo de la pelota, como el del lenguaje –puestos en buenos pies y manos– son un desafío a la creatividad. Una colección de cuentos futboleros, corregida y también aumentada con la inclusión del portentoso relato titulado «Campitos». Sasturain documenta aquello que sostenía en sus años de joven recién llegado a Buenos Aires: lo suyo en la vida iba a tener que ver con la literatura y el fútbol. En Letras (y en una obra radiante, que cuanto más se dispersa en términos genéricos resulta más personal, más, diríase, sasturánica) le fue bastante mejor que en la prueba que hizo en San Lorenzo y en su breve paso por Lanús. Colgó los botines enseguida, se pasó a este otro rectángulo de juego y estos relatos son la evidencia palmaria (como diría un relator atascado en el lugar común) de lo bien que hizo.

Dormir juntos una noche

Narrada detalladamente y con emoción, la historia principal se fragmenta en otras que se anudan a través de unos personajes llenos de matices que comparten el mismo telón de fondo: Pablo Escobar manejando los hilos y las vidas de todos, como si fuesen sus marionetas, haciéndoles bailar y saltar al son que él quiere tocar; y en el momento que lo quiere tocar. Firma con mi nombre

«Gloria Felipe miró la primera plana del periódico recién impreso como si mirara un barco entrando de noche al mar abierto. Amalia

The ways in which women have historically authorized themselves to write on war has blurred conventionally gendered lines, intertwining the personal with the political. *Women on War in Spain's Long Nineteenth Century* explores, through feminist lenses, the cultural representations of late nineteenth- and early twentieth-century Spanish women's texts on war. Reshaping the current knowledge and understanding of key female authors in Spain's fin de siècle, this book examines works by notable writers – including Rosario de Acuña, Blanca de los Ríos, Concepción Arenal, and Carmen de Burgos – as they engage with the War of Independence, the Third Carlist War, Spain's colonial wars, and World War I. The selected works foreground how women's representations of war can challenge masculine conceptualizations of public and domestic spheres. Christine Arkinstall analyses the works' overarching themes and symbols, such as honour, blood, the Virgin and the Mother, and the intersecting sexual, social, and racial contracts. In doing so, Arkinstall highlights how these texts imagine outcomes that deviate from established norms of femininity, offer new models to Spanish women, and interrogate the militaristic foundations of patriarchal societies.

Fascismo, kitsch y cine histórico español, 1939-1953

¡Son Tres!

Para poder acercarnos al fenómeno y tema de la 'filosofía andina' es preciso romper con el euro-centrismo y occidentalismo implícitos en la misma definición y delimitación de lo que se considera 'pensamiento filosófico'. La obra opta por un enfoque intercultural. La filosofía intercultural, antes que una corriente con contenidos determinados, es una manera de ver, una actitud comprometida, un cierto hábito intelectual que penetra todos los esfuerzos filosóficos. Es sobre todo una 'filosofía de la interculturalidad', es decir: una reflexión sobre las condiciones y los límites de un diálogo (o 'polílogo') entre las culturas. La filosofía andina es preponderantemente, la epifanía sapiencial del 'otro' en su

condición de pobre, marginado, alienado, despojado y olvidado, pero desde la 'gloria' de su riqueza humana, cultural y filosófica.

Una ricahembra

No ha muchos días me hallaba yo en una tertulia, y como las materias de conversación se hubiesen agotado, uno de los concurrentes propuso esta antiquísima, trivial y manoseada cuestión: "¿cuál es el más feliz de los mortales?". Varios fueron los pareceres. Unos atribuyeron al amor la virtud de hacer felices a los hombres, otros a la salud; quién se decidió por la riqueza, quién por el poder, quién por la paz doméstica. Dos de los que estaban presentes se acordaron de cierto pasaje del Telémaco, y el uno dijo que, en su sentir, el mortal más dichoso es un rey que teme a los dioses y que labra la felicidad de sus pueblos; el otro afirmó que la persona verdaderamente feliz es la que cree serlo. Suscitose al oír este último parecer un murmullo aprobatorio; pero el sujeto que había propuesto la cuestión no se dio por satisfecho y sentó la proposición de que el mortal más feliz es un ama de leche³. Añadió que, aunque esta felicidad es casi infinita, no deja de tener sus grados, y que, si los padres de la criatura que se cría son acomodados y aprehensivos, aquella dicha, pasando por encima de todos los grados de comparación, alcanza al superlativo, y no como quiera al superlativo absoluto (felicissimus) sino al superlativo relativo (felicissimus omnium) el más feliz de todos⁴. "Me he penetrado de esta verdad —prosiguió el sustentante— no por medio de reflexiones hechas al aire, sino por medio de observaciones diarias que he podido hacer en casa de un hermano mío, casado y padre de un hijo que vino al mundo después de otros dos que, ni de la cuna siquiera, sino de la artesa, pasaron al sepulcro.

El viandante. Bien y mal

Esta es la primera reedición completa del Museo de cuadros de costumbres y variedades (1866). Compuesta por 97 textos cortos y la primera impresión completa de la novela Manuela, de Eugenio Díaz, esta compilación fue editada por Vergara y Vergara como un álbum de recortes a partir de periódicos publicados desde 1846 y hasta 1866. A la manera de otras compilaciones, como Los españoles pintados por sí mismos (1843-1844) o Los cubanos pintados por sí mismos (1852), Vergara buscaba que el Museo representara el álbum familiar de Colombia. A partir de tipos humanos, eventos históricos y paisajes emblemáticos del país, el Museo debía ser leído no solo por un público colombiano, sino por uno español. Este libro es una obra mayor del siglo xix colombiano y una contribución clave de la cultura letrada decimonónica que ha permanecido al margen de los debates actuales sobre la época. Como pieza literaria, es una de las expresiones más acabadas del conservadurismo de mediados del siglo xix, en tanto propone a Colombia como una extensión de España. Como tal, el Museo fue una reacción a las reformas liberales de la época. Estas pretendían, por una parte, la independencia cultural frente a España y, por otra, a través de empresas estatales como la Comisión Co-rográfica (1850-1859), organizar al país en torno a signos distintos a la religión católica o las costumbres hispanas. Aparte de enmarcar este texto en los debates acerca de las reformas liberales en Colombia, esta reedición inserta al Museo en el movimiento global de la escritura de tipos y costumbres y rescata del archivo los periódicos de los cuales Vergara extrajo sus cuadros. Contiene 32 ilustraciones de la cultura visual de la época.

El otro día del perenne

De forma repentina e inexplicable, una parte de la población mundial se queda dormida mientras que otra se vuelve insomne. El Sueño convierte la vida en un pesadillesco presente continuo para quienes quedan despiertos. Será el telón de fondo para contar cinco historias que transcurren en distintos países. La de Audrey, en Estados Unidos, a quien se le duermen su esposo y sus tres hijos. La de Bárbara, en Ciudad de México, que queda insomne junto con su novia, con quien descubre que necesita comer una segunda cena de madrugada y empiezan a cocinarla para otros insomnes. La de Emily, en Londres, que cambia las raves de música electrónica y MDMA por fiestas en las que la gente se junta a verse dormir. La historia de Hiroshi, en Tokio, quien ya no necesita dormir y por eso trabaja veinte horas diarias de corrido. Y la de Sebastián, en Buenos Aires, quien trabaja en una casa de sueño, una especie de geriátrico donde la gente manda a sus durmientes para que los cuiden porque nadie sabe muy bien qué hacer con ellos. Estas historias nunca se cruzan, pero se imitan y se espejan: todas cuentan las mismas pérdidas y similares maneras de sobrevivencia. Y en todas están el sueño, el dormir, la vigilia, el soñar, el despertar, el insomnio, que en sus diversas formas atraviesan la novela.

La enseñanza objetiva

Strong in the Rain

Kenji Miyazawa (1896-1933) is now widely viewed as Japan's greatest poet of the 20th century. Ian Wedde has been a major presence in New Zealand poetry since his work began appearing in journals in the late 1960s. His first book of poetry appeared in 1971; his sixth book won the New Zealand Book Award for Poetry in 1978; his sixteenth and most recent was a finalist in 2014. By the mid-1980s, as well as shaping his own verse, he had become an influential critic and shaper of larger trends in poetry as one of the co-editors of *The Penguin Book of New Zealand Verse* (1985) and *The Penguin Book of Contemporary New Zealand Poetry – Ng Kupu T+tohu o Aotearoa* (1989). After a quiet spell in the mid- to late 1990s came the much celebrated *The Commonplace Odes* in 2001, in which Wedde offered the Horatian/Keatsian ode as transformative a moment as Baxter had given the sonnet back in 1970. Three excellent books followed, most recently *The Lifeguard: Poems 2008–2013*, published at the end of his tenure as New Zealand Poet Laureate. While Wedde has constantly experimented with and pushed boundaries of form and influence in his poetry, his work returns often to key themes and ideas, preoccupations and effects that this book throws into brilliant relief: a politics of language, social and ecological relationships, how memory works, the perceptual world. The son Carlos of *Earthly: Sonnets for Carlos* (1975) is now a father himself; Ian Wedde's poems are now more likely to feature grandchildren. But the ranging, tenacious, conceptual-romantic poet, with his linguistically rich but intellectually rigorous voice, is the same, and tracing that voice through nearly five decades will be one of the many pleasures readers take from this book. With selections from 1971's *Homage to Matisse* all the way through to 2013's *The Lifeguard*, Ian Wedde's *Selected Poems* will introduce readers new and old to one of New Zealand's most distinguished contemporary poets.

Swimming in the Rain

Nemerov's sense of the satirical is best seen in shorter offerings, where he takes a literary look at life from the other end of the telescope. A superb introduction to the works of one of the 20th Century's most subversive scribes. Howard Nemerov (1920 – 1991) was an American novelist and poet, who won the Pulitzer Prize in 1978. His novels are characterised by the use of self-deprecating wit and an ongoing sense of irony. While his books tended to satirise 20th Century American life, his poems often focussed on the beauty and innocence of nature. In addition, Nemerov also worked as a scriptwriter, most notably on the film, ‘Tall Story,’ starring Anthony Perkins and Jane Fonda.

Princeton Alumni Weekly

This critical edition of the poems of Anna Seward (1742-1809) re-establishes one of the most popular and prolific poets of the early Romantic period. Her work influenced Charlotte Smith and Mary Robinson and later both Wordsworth and Coleridge. Her reputation was so high that Sir Walter Scott edited the posthumous edition of her poems in 1810. Unlike Scott's, this edition reproduces the poems as they were first published in periodicals and collections during Seward's lifetime, allowing scholars to experience them as eighteenth century readers did. It also includes more than 200 poems that were excluded from the Scott edition.
