Triterpenoids Triperpenoids, generally are obtained by biogenesis from six isoprene units, They are found to share commonly the acyclic precursor squalene (Co). Based on the various possible modes, whereby ring closure in squalene takes place may ultimately give rise to a large number of triterpenoids having a variety of skeleton structures.

The triperpenoids may be categorized into two major groups, namely: the tetracyclic and the pentacyclic compounds: the former ones of the steriodal types with C-27 carbon atoms present in the skeleton while the latter are of the triterpenoid types with C-30 carbon atoms as shown below Microscopic Characterstics The transverse section reveals several yellow-brown cork layers, and a layer of phelloderm that is to 3 cells thick. The cortex exhibits medullary rays, and obliterated sieve portions radiate alternately.
