The Black Arts Enterprise and the Production of African American Poetry

Young black boys are not taught about aesthetics. Throughout my upbringing I learned a great deal of what others think a man is supposed to be. I learned about masculinity, strength, endurance, courage, Moral and all the things fundamental and essential to what "makes a man" .When I was going to elementary school I picked out a pair of white and blue sneakers that my father called "Cinderella" Slippers" as an insult. To me, it was a compliment. He didn't know what beauty was. It was evident in the way he treated my mother. I soon learned what beauty was. When I was in middle school I saw a boy who I couldn't keep my eyes off of. You know the type? Tall, dark, handsome. Dreamy brown eyes, with fluttering eyelashes. It was all in a photograph and it was beautiful. When I saw him in person it was a dream come true. The most beautiful being I've ever saw with a very prestigious name to match. Diamond. My mother didn't recognize his beauty and she tore me from him. How could she not see what I saw? How desperately I wanted to be apart of his beauty, his light, longing, seeking his aesthetic. When I was in high school I showed up to my English class in shades, sea shells and a walk that said "Look at me, I'm not hiding anything" but deep down I was. I didn't know what beauty was, I looked for it in all the wrong places, my search for beauty at such a young age broke me mentally. Mothers why do you not teach your sons that they are as beautiful as your daughters?! Fathers why do you lead your sons to believe that they are not worthy of feeling beautiful? Who created the mentality that beauty is feminine? Why do we not associate masculinity with beauty? I didn't learn about aesthetics until high school. My art teacher said the word and it stuck with me. Aes-thet-ic/esETHedik/Learn to pronounceadjective 1. concerned with beauty or the appreciation of beauty. Such a powerful word, to study what makes something beautiful, visually appealing, in awe to look at. I always thought I was ugly. I never imagined being the one anyone would look at as beautiful. I desperately wanted to be beautiful, to be loved, to be pleasing to the eye others, but no one saw me. I acted in ways to receive attention that put me in predicaments I'm not proud of. Searching for beauty. In college I had long hair and cut it. Who I saw in the inside didn't match who I saw on the outside. I was no longer pleased with the way I looked. Cutting it made me feel beautiful. Before cutting it...No one made me feel beautiful. The ones who did manipulated me into situations that have forever scared me. Still studying beauty. I forgave, that was beautiful, I moved on, that was beautiful and even on my darkest days, I found a Light with a name that shatters the walls of illumination. Luminous Lumens. I've never felt beautiful, I probably never will. But I will forever teach my black boys their aesthetic: The ESSENCE of Beauty.

Window of Hope

Tapestries of Hope, Threads of Love tells the story of ordinary women living in terror and extreme poverty under General Pinochet's oppressive rule in Chile (1973–1989). These women defied the military dictatorship by embroidering their sorrow on scraps of cloth, using needles and thread as one of the boldest means of popular protest and resistance in Latin America. The arpilleras they made—patchwork tapestries with scenes of everyday life and memorials to their disappeared relatives—were smuggled out of Chile and brought to the world the story of their fruitless searches in jails, morgues, government offices, and the tribunals of law for their husbands, brothers, and sons. Marjorie Agosín, herself a native of and exile from Chile, has spent more than thirty years interviewing the arpilleristas and following their work. She knows their stories intimately and knows, too, that none of them has ever found a disappeared relative alive. Even though the dictatorship ended in 1989 and democracy returned to Chile, no full account of the detained and disappeared has ever been offered. Still, many women maintain hope and continue to make arpilleras, both in memory and as art. This new edition of the book, updated for students, includes a reaction to the death of General Pinochet, a chronology of Chile, several new testimonies from arpilleristas in their own words, and an introduction by Peter Kornbluh. It retains a section of full-color plates of arpilleras, an afterword by Peter Winn, and a foreword by Isabel Allende. These essays reflect on personal fishing experiences with a strong evocation of place and an attempt to understand humans' relationship with water and public land in the American West.

Tracks of Hope

The most popular source of theological hope for American Christians is that of Jrgen Moltmann. Preachers, teachers, and lay people reflect Moltmann's influence, with their hope in a this-worldly eschatology and a suffering God. However, an exclusive reliance on that hope deprives the church of crucial resources in the face of global economic, environmental, and military crises. This book explores Moltmannian hope and considers its costs before looking elsewhere for additional contributions, from Thomas Aquinas's theological virtue of hope to nihilism and beyond, in order to encourage the church to sustain and practice hope in Jesus Christ, our only hope.

Wilderness of Hope

These two volumes chronicle the life of a liberal Jew who came of age in Germany during the relatively enlightened period of the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Rudolf Moos obtained his education in Ulm and, after working in his familys leather business, went in hope to seek his fortune in Berlin. He founded Salamander, the largest shoe business in Germany, which is still active today. He was a German patriot, who served his country in World War I and received a War Merit Cross (Kriegsverdienstkreuz) for his endeavors. Rudolf Moos lived in Germany in growing despair through the political upheaval and hyperinflation in the aftermath of World War I. He was related to and enjoyed a friendship with Albert Einstein when they both lived in Berlin in the 1920s and early 1930s. Rudolf Moos then experienced the rise of the Nazis and the ever-growing restrictions placed on him and members of his extended family. Anti-Jewish sentiment in Germany rose sharply during 1933, which effectively ended his active life in business and community affairs and give him unsought free time to set out the story of his life. He and his wife were eventually permitted to leave Germany and immigrate to England, where he continued to work on his memoirs during the turmoil of World War II. Volume I of Rudolf Moos memoirs, Rise and Fall, describes the poisoned atmosphere existing for the Jews in the Germany of the late 1930s, sets out his experiences of humiliation and arrest, the breath of freedom on leaving his Homeland, and his arrival in England as a penniless alien. Chapter 1 focuses on Rudolf Moos origins and his fathers family and leather manufacturing company, which initiated trade with East India in the 1880s. It describes the background of Rudolf Moos mother, who was a member of the Einstein family, and provides details about the lives of Rafael and Rupert Einstein, her father and grandfather.
