How can you define assessment and evaluation in education?

What is Assessment? In the field of education, assessment is the process of documenting, measuring and describing what students know and can do (Moses, 2014)

formative assessments. (assessments conducted during learning in order to provide feedback that helps students improve their understanding)

summative assessments (assessments designed to measure how much a student has learned at the end of a unit or school year)

and portfolio assessments (a collection of student work that demonstrates what they have learned over time)

What is Evaluation in education?

Evaluation is actually a process that has many purposes and can be used in a variety of ways.

In order to measure the effectiveness of an educational program

it is important to first understand the meaning of evaluation.

Evaluation has been described as "the systematic collection and analysis of information to determine the merit, worth, or value of something" Scriven (1991).

Donaldson & Christie (2006: 250) claim that Evaluation generates information for decision making, often answering the bottom-line questions: "Why does it work?" "For whom does it work best?" "Under what conditions does it work?" "How do we make it better?"

When used in the context of education, evaluation refers to the process of assessing and documenting what students have learned and how well they have learned it.

How do you know if the student has learned something?

Evaluation can help educators determine what methods of instruction work best for students and which strategies need to be changed or discontinued.

Thus, the need for evaluation in education is critical.

The Purpose of Assessment and Evaluation

Assessment is the process of gathering information in order to make decisions.

Evaluation is the use of that information to make judgments about students, programs, or schools.

Formal assessment is more common in schools, while evaluation is more common in businesses.

In evaluation, the results of assessment are used to inform decisions about what a school should be doing, but they do not necessarily direct programmatic changes.

Assessment involves multiple steps.

The first step is to establish the assessment purpose and to determine the types of data that will be collected.

When to use assessment is a difficult question because it can depend on the context and what you are trying to assess.

Generally, though, assessment can be used to measure progress, diagnose learning problems, and determine if instruction is effective.

Assessment is not an exact science and there are many factors to consider when deciding the best time to use assessment.

A teacher's role is to help students learn, and one way to do this is to assess their learning outcomes This involves determining what students know and

This process should include identifying trends and patterns as well as determining which factors are most influencing student success. Finally, the findings of the evaluation should be used to inform future decisions about teaching and learning.

The artist's famous tapestry cartoons are included, along with the tapestries woven after them for the royal palaces of the Prado and the Escorial. Goya's infamous Naked Maja and Clothed Maja are also highlighted, with a discussion on whether these works were painted at the same time and how they might have originally hung in relation to one another. Focus is also placed on Goya's more experimental prints and drawings, in which the artist depicted women alternatively as targets of satire, of sympathy, or of admiration. Essays by eminent authorities provide a historical and cultural context for Goya's work, including a discussion on the significance of fashion and dress during the period. The resultant volume is surely to be treasured by all who admire Goya's art and by those who are interested in women's issues of his time.

Scheherazade Goes West

Throughout my childhood, my grandmother Yasmina, who was illiterate and grew up in a harem, repeated that to travel is the best way to learn and to empower yourself. "When a woman decides to use her wings, she takes big risks," she would tell me, but she was convinced that if you didn't use them, it hurt.... So recalls Fatema Mernissi at the outset of her mesmerizing new book. Of all the lessons she learned from her grandmother -- whose home was, after all, a type of prison -- the most central was that the opportunity to cross boundaries was a sacred privilege. Indeed, in journeys both physical and mental, Mernissi has spent virtually all of her life traveling -- determined to "use her wings" and to renounce her gender's alleged legacy of powerlessness. Bursting with the vitality of Mernissi's personality and of her rich heritage, *Scheherazade Goes West* reveals the author's unique experiences as a liberated, independent Moroccan woman faced with the peculiarities and unexpected encroachments of Western culture. Her often surprising discoveries about the conditions of and attitudes toward women around the world -- and the exquisitely embroidered amalgam of clear-eyed autobiography and dazzling meta-fiction by which she relates those assorted discoveries -- add up to a deliciously wry, engagingly cosmopolitan, and deeply penetrating narrative. In her previous bestselling works, Mernissi -- widely recognized as the world's greatest living Koranic scholar and Islamic sociologist -- has shed unprecedented light on the lives of women in the Middle East. Now, as a writer and scholarly veteran of the high-wire act of straddling disparate societies, she trains her eyes on the female culture of the West. For her book's inspired central metaphor, Mernissi turns to the ancient Islamic tradition of oral storytelling, illuminating her grandmother's feminized, subversive, and highly erotic take on Scheherazade's wife-preserving tales from *The Arabian Nights* -- and then ingeniously applying them to her own lyrically embellished personal narrative. Interwoven with vivid ruminations on her childhood, her education, and her various international travels are the author's piquant musings on a range of deeply embedded societal conditions that add up, Mernissi argues, to a veritable "Western harem." A provocative and lively challenge to the common assumption that women have it so much better in the West than anywhere else in the world, Mernissi's book is an entrancing and timely look at the way we live here and now. By inspiring us to reconsider even the most commonplace aspects of our culture with fresh eyes and a healthy dose of suspicion, *Scheherazade Goes West* offers an invigorating, candid, and entertaining new perspective on the themes and ideas to which Betty Friedan first turned us on nearly forty years ago.

Will this generation of immigrant children follow the path of earlier waves of immigrants and gradually assimilate into mainstream American life, or does the global nature of the contemporary world mean that the trajectory of today's immigrants will be fundamentally different? Rather than severing their ties to their home countries, many immigrants today sustain economic, political, and religious ties to their homelands, even as they work, vote, and pray in the countries that receive them. *The Changing Face of Home* is the first book to examine the extent to which the children of immigrants engage in such transnational practices. Because most second generation immigrants are still young, there is much debate among immigration scholars about the extent to which these children will engage in transnational practices in the future. While the contributors to this volume find some evidence of transnationalism among the children of immigrants, they disagree over whether these activities will have any long-term effects. Part I of the volume explores how the practice and consequences of transnationalism vary among different groups. Contributors Philip Kasinitz, Mary Waters, and John Mollenkopf use findings from their large study of immigrant communities in New York City to show how both distance and politics play important roles in determining levels of transnational activity. For example, many Latin American and Caribbean immigrants are "circular migrants" spending much time in both their home countries and the United States, while Russian Jews and Chinese immigrants have far less contact of any kind with their homelands. In Part II, the contributors comment on these findings, offering suggestions for reconceptualizing the issue and bridging analytical differences. In her chapter, Nancy Foner makes valuable comparisons with past waves of immigrants as a way of understanding the conditions that may foster or mitigate transnationalism among today's immigrants. The final set of chapters examines how home and host country value systems shape how second generation immigrants construct their identities, and the economic, social, and political communities to which they ultimately express allegiance. *The Changing Face of Home* presents an important first round of research and dialogue on the activities and identities of the second generation vis-a-vis their ancestral homelands, and raises important questions for future research.

The Changing Face of Home

María Sánchez is obsessed with what she cannot see. As a field veterinarian following in the footsteps of generations before her, she travels the countryside of Spain bearing witness to a life eroding before her eyes—words, practices, and people slipping away because of depopulation, exploitation of natural resources, inadequate environmental policies, and development encroaching on farmland and villages. In doing so, she asks difficult questions about gender equity and labor. Part memoir and part rural feminist manifesto, *Land of Women* acknowledges the sacrifices of Sánchez's female ancestors who enabled her to become the woman she is. A bestseller in Spain, *Land of Women* promises to ignite conversations about the treatment and perception of rural communities everywhere.

The Teaching and Learning of Arabic in Early Modern Europe

This book further qualifies the postcolonial thesis and shows its limits. To reach these goals, it links text analysis and political history on a global comparative scale. Focusing on imperial agents, their narratives of progress, and their political aims and strategies, it asks whether Enlightenment gave birth to a new colonialism between 1760 and 1820. Has Enlightenment provided the cultural and intellectual origins of modern colonialism? For decades, historians of political thought, philosophy, and literature have debated this question. On one side, many postcolonial authors believe that enlightened rationalism helped delegitimize non-European cultures. On the other side, some historians of ideas and literature are willing to defend at least some eighteenth-century philosophers whom they consider to have been "anti-colonialists". Surprisingly enough, both sides have focused on literary and philosophical texts, but have rarely taken political and social practice into account.
