Sejarah Peradaban Islam

Selain itu, di antara sejarawan–sejarawan umum dan sejarawan–sejarawan agama, terdapat sejarawan–sejarawan budaya yang mencermati perkembangan–perkembangan agama dalam kerangka kebudayaan yang lebih luas, yang pada saatnya juga berkaitan dengan sejarah politik dan sejarah militer. Di Indonesia, misalnya, kita mengenal nama Marshal G.S. Hodgson lewat The Venture of Islam (Chicago & London: The Univ. of Chicago Press, 1975 [3 jilid]), secara gemilang berusaha meletakkan sejarah total Islam dalam konteks sejarah dunia dengan Islam sebagai sumbunya.

Arkeologi Islam Nusantara

Berbicara tentang sejarah bermakna bercerita tentang masa lalu, sebab sejarah adalah peristiwa, kejadian atau riwayat yang benar-benar terjadi pada masa lalu. Benarkah sejarah tak pernah bohong?, sejarah tidak pernah berbohong, sebab sejarah dibuktikan dengan peninggalan budaya[1]. Oleh sebab itu sejarah, baru bisa disebut sebagai sejarah, apabila ia meninggalkan bukti masa lalunya. Tanpa bukti maka sejarah tersebut hanya akan menjadi dongeng belaka. Mengapa orang perlu belajar tentang sejarah?, Bukankah orang harus melihat ke masa depannya bukan kebelakang (masa lalu)?. Perlu dipahami bahwa sejarah bukan hanya sekedar peristiwa, kejadian atau riwayat masa lalu, yaa,. memang ia terjadi pada masa lalu akan tetapi sejarah adalah teropong masa depan. Orang yang meninggalkan sejarahnya bermakna ia merusak masa depannya, orang yang melupakan sejarahnya bermakna ia tidak bisa melihat ke masa depannya. [1] Wujud kebudayaan merupakan bentuk yang dihasilkan oleh pemikiran kebudayaan. Adapun wujud kebudayaan menurut J.J. Hoenigman, ada tiga wujud kebudayaan, yakni: Pertama, Gagasan yaitu wujud kebudayaan yang berupa gagasan, ide, nilai, norma, peraturan, dan lain sebagainya. Sifatnya abstrak, tidak dapat diraba, disentuh dan bukan barang yang nyata. Jika gagasan ini dalam bentuk tulisan, maka lokasi dari kebudayaan tersebut berada dalam karangan-karangan atau tulisan-tulisan. Misalnya: kitab kuno, prasasti dan lain sebagainya. Kedua, Aktivitas yaitu tindakan atau aktivitas manusia yang berasal dari pemikiran kebudayaan. Wujud kedua ini sering disebut dengan sistem sosial, terdiri dari aktivitas-aktivitas manusia yang sering berinteraksi. Sifatnya nyata, terjadi di sekeliling kita sehari-hari, dapat diamati dan didokumentasikan. Misalnya: sistem adat, sistem kemasyarakatan dan lain sebagainya. Ketiga, Artefak yaitu wujud fisik berupa hasil aktivitas atau karya manusia dalam masyarakat yang berupa benda-benda atau hal-hal yang dapat diraba, dilihat, didokumentasikan serta sifatnya wujud konkret. Misalnya: Patung, bangunan dan lain sebagainya.

Science and Civilization in Islam

Tabut ialah sebuah tradisi atau budaya lokal Bengkulu berupa upacara untuk mengenang kematian cucu Nabi Muhammad Saw, Husen bin Ali, di Padang Karbala Irak. Disusun dalam lima bab, semoga buku ini dapat memberikan sumbangsih informasi seputar tradisi Tabut dan menambah khazanah keilmuan serta dinamika akademik bagi para peminat kajian sejenis.

Islam dan Budaya Lokal dalam Tradisi Tabut

Pada awal abad ke-19, kemajuan ilmu pengetahuan dan teknologi modern mulai merambah dunia Islam. Periode ini dalam sejarah Islam dianggap sebagai awal periode kontak modern dengan dunia Barat, yang kemudian membawa ide-ide baru ke dunia Muslim seperti nasionalisme, demokrasi, dll. Semua ini menimbulkan masalah baru dan para pemimpin Muslim mulai berpikir tentang bagaimana menyelesaikan masalah baru ini. Lebih jauh lagi, seperti halnya di dunia Barat, di dunia Islam juga muncul berbagai ideologi dan gerakan untuk menyesuaikan pemahaman agama Islam dengan perkembangan baru yang dibawa oleh kemajuan ilmu pengetahuan dan teknologi modern. Buku dihadapan penulis ini menyajikan pemikiran dan gerakan pembaharuan Islam yang muncul pada masa yang sering disebut periode modern sejarah Islam. Inovasi meliputi reformasi yang terjadi di tiga negara muslim yang menjadi tolak ukur reformasi Islam yang ada di Indonesia.

GERAKAN PEMIKIRAN TOKOH ISLAM PROGRESIF INDONESIA

Kebudayaan dan peradaban Islam di era globalisasi ini dihadapkan pada sejumlah masalah yang kompleks dan pelik, terutama terkait dengan isu-isu aktual seputar modernisasi, westernisasi, sekularisasi, moralitas sekuler, dan budaya teenage tyranny. Di satu sisi, umat Islam memandang budaya Barat sebagai bentuk kebudayaan unggul yang perlu diteladani sebagai medium untuk mengatasi kejumudan dan keterbelakangan umat Islam di bidang sains dan teknologi. Namun, di sisi lain, budaya Barat yang

sedang mengalami krisis spiritual dapat menjadi mesin penghancur bagi nilai-nilai adiluhung Islam itu sendiri. Bahkan, sebaliknya, sejumlah ilmuwan Barat justru memandang Islam sebagai oase yang diharapkan mampu mengatasi kekeringan spiritual yang sedang mereka alami. Maka, pada momen inilah dibutuhkan suatu dialog peradaban antara Barat dan Islam, alih-alih clash civilization. Paradigma konflik dalam kesejarahan dua peradaban ini sudah semestinya dikubur, mengingat masalah yang dihadapi oleh yang satu hampir tidak dapat diatasi tanpa “uluran tangan” yang lainnya. Namun, mengapa harus Islam, dan bukan agama lain, yang dianggap mampu menjadi problem solver terhadap masalah yang melilit peradaban Barat? Buku ini menyediakan alasannya. Buku karya Prof. Dr. H. Faisal Ismail, M.A. ini merindukan suatu momen romantik antara Islam dan Barat untuk sebuah dunia dan kehidupan yang menawan bagi generasi umat manusia masa depan.

Islam Dinamika Dialogis Keilmuan, Kebudayaan, dan Kemanusiaan

Pembahasan dalam buku ini akan membicarakan dua kemaslahatan tersebut dalam perspektif yang lebih luas. Artinya, ketika membicarakan hubungan Pancasila dan Islam misalnya, maka dilihat bagaimana sejarah yang digali sehingga menghasilkan kesepakatan diterimanya Pancasila sebagai sebuah landasan negara. Meskipun awalnya kaum muslimin merasa keberatan dengan keputusan tersebut. Karena yang mereka idealkan adalah landasan negara merupakan penerapan dari ajaran Islam secara eksplisit. Namun, pada hakikatnya pun, kita dapat melihat dan menyadari bahwa substansi Pancasila sangat Islam sekali. Hal ini dapat dilihat dalam butir-butirnya. Sila pertama berbicara tentang ketauhidan kepada Allah SWT. dan butir berikutnya merepresentasikan ajaran-ajaran syariat. Maka perspektif kemaslahatan seperti dijelaskan di muka yang membuat akhirnya kesepakatan diterimanya Pancasila sebagai landasan negara.

The aim of this book is to explain how mys ticism originated and developed in the Islamic world. The author has made an attempt to analyse the chief elements of the so called Islamic mysticism and to show in what way its basic principles are related to the fundamental tenets of Islam. It was necessary for this purpose to give a brief account of the founder of Islam and his companions, and to show how their life could have helped to suggest and develop the chief mystic theories among the Muslims. It is purported to be a criticism of the origin and development of the Sufi movement among the Muslims, in the light of the Quran and Traditions of the prophet, the two chief sources of knowledge about Islam. Western orientalists have been writing volu minous books with regard to the development of Mystic theories in the Islamic world. But very often their efforts are marred by their reli ance on the works of unknown authors. Their inferences from such works give an impression to the readers that the Muslim Mystics had lived a life absolutely different from the life and tenets of the founder of Islam. Their writings seem to suggest that Muslim saints had chalked out for themselves a path of spiritual progress, which had yi very little in common with the path of the prophet and his companions, and almost invariably aim at proving that this new path founded by these saints in some way made amends for the inherent defects of Islam as a theory of life. There is nothing farther from the truth than this suggestion of the Western scholars. The present writer has made an humble attempt to prove that the Muslim saints, the original founders of the different Sufi sects, were pious Muslims trying to follow the path of the prophet like the rest of believers, differing only in this respect that they were distinguished for their sincerity, piety, love and fear of God and their zeal in following the prophet in every detail of conduct. The later accretions to the Sufi theories were partly due to the peculiar conditions of the disin tegrating and degenerating Islamic society and partly due to the foreign influences which in the end deprived the Islamic faith of its pristine puri ty. Various movements started in the Islamic world with a view to purging Islamic society of foreign elements have also been briefly described in the end. The author has tried to rely on well known Sufi writers and has as far as possible avoided reference to books of doubtful authority. The works consulted are given in the footnotes in their respective places. My thanks are due to Dr. Sir Badhakrishna, at present the Vice-Chancellor of Andhra University, yii who went through the manuscript when he was Chairman of the Post-Graduates Studies at Calcutta. My special thanks, however, are due to my esteemed friend Dr. U. M. Daudpota, M. A., Ph. D. Cantab., Professor of Arabic at the Ismatf
